


WHAT: The Informational Public Meeting will present to the communities the interchange options that have been evaluated for the intersection of Rivers Edge Road and US 29 (Columbia Pike). Displays and maps depicting those alternatives will be available for review.

SHA representatives will discuss the advantages and disadvantages of each alternative, address the potential environmental and right-of-way impacts associated with those alternatives, and explain traffic operations during construction.

A formal presentation lasting approximately 30 minutes will begin at 6:00 PM. You may arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through the display area at your own pace.

BACKGROUND: As a result of the continuing growth of the US 29 corridor in Howard County, SHA has been working with the surrounding communities since 2010 to identify and provide traffic-management solutions. In 2011, SHA divided the corridor improvements into two phases and expects to complete Phase 1, which is currently under construction from south of Seneca Drive to MD 175, by fall 2016. Phase 2, which was placed on hold to allow SHA to evaluate interchange options for the intersection of Rivers Edge Road and US 29, includes the addition of a third through lane northbound on US 29 from Middle Patuxent River to south of Seneca Drive. Phase 2 will eliminate the traffic signal and construct a grade-separated interchange at the intersection of Rivers Edge Road and US 29.
